The Chugiak - Eagle River Borough Association is an unincorporated association of registered voters of the Chugiak - Eagle River area.

The Chairman, Lee B. Jordan, mailing address P. O. Box 700, Eagle River, Alaska, 99577, is designated as attorney-in-fact to receive service, notice and all other correspondence relating to the proceedings in behalf of the petitioners.

Petition 1A

(3) The boundaries of the area to be detached, known as the Chugiak - Eagle River area consisting of Fire Lake, Birchwood, Peters Creek, Eklutna, Eagle River Valley, South Fork, Chugiak and Eagle River, stated in the legal description and illustrated by the map attached as Exhibit A are as follows:

All that land included in the Greater Anchorage Area Borough and lying northerly of the following line: commencing in Knik Arm on the west boundary of the Greater Anchorage Area Borough and on the south boundary of Section 17, T14N, R3W, S.M; thence east along the south boundary of sections 17, 16, 15, 14 and 13, T14N, R3W, S.M; thence east along the south boundary of sections 18, 17, and 16, T14N, R2W, S.M; thence south between sections 21 and 22, thence east along the south boundary of sections 22, 23, and 24, T14N, R2W, S.M; thence southeasterly to the southwest protracted corner of section 1, T12N, R1W, S.M; thence southeasterly to the southwest protracted corner of section 34, T12N, R2E, S.M; thence east along the south boundaries of townships 12N, ranges 2E, 3E, 4E and 5E to the east boundary of the Greater Anchorage Area Borough.

(4) The 1970 Census of Population lists 5,832 persons living in the Eagle River - Chugiak community.

The Greater Anchorage Area Borough publication, Preliminary Comprehensive Development Plan, Volume 1, February 1973, states the following under the heading, "Population Characteristics of Small Areas:"

"Certain communities have shown significant increases in actual and relative population growth. Communities that have grown at a faster rate than the Borough as a whole are Muldoon, Lake Otis, Sand Lake and Eagle River - Chugiak." (Emphasis added)

The same publication projects the population of the Eagle River - Chugiak community as tabulated:

The Chugiak - Eagle River Borough Association agrees with the Greater Anchorage Area Borough that the estimated 1975 population is 10,010 based upon the data and evaluation listed in the attached Exhibit B.

(5) The quantity of land within the boundaries of the area to be detached is approximately 53,200 acres or approximately 830 square miles.

(6) The assessed value of all real and personal property within the area to be detached is shown as follows in the Greater Anchorage Area Borough Annual Budget, Fiscal Year 1975 - 1976:

The foregoing assessed value is based on 1975 assessments. Supporting data and evaluation is listed in detail in Exhibit C.

(7) The current (Fiscal Year 1975) rates at which real and personal property are taxed in the area to be detached are as follows:

(8) Based on a percentage of assessed value, it has been determined that the area proposed for incorporation has an obligation for 5.27003629% of the 1975 debt of the Greater

Anchorage Area Borough. Of the total of \$107,995,000 principal and \$56,131,791.09 interest, the portion attributable to Chugiak - Eagle River totals \$8,649,540 combined principal and interest. Debt service for Chugiak - Eagle River in Fiscal Year 1976 would be \$560,960 less anticipated state contribution of \$266,456.

II. CLASS: The petitioners seek to incorporate a borough of the second class.

III. NAME: The name of the proposed borough shall be the Chugiak - Eagle River Borough.

IV. BOUNDARIES: The boundaries of the proposed borough, more particularly stated and illustrated by the map attached as Exhibit A are as follows:

Petition 1B

All that land included in the Greater Anchorage Area Borough and lying northerly of the following line: commencing in Knik Arm on the west boundary of the Greater Anchorage Area Borough and on the south boundary of Section 17, T14N, R3W, S. M; thence east along the south boundary of sections 17, 16, 15, 14 and 13, T14N, R3W, S. M; thence east along the south boundary of sections 18, 17, and 16, T14N, R2W, S. M; thence south between sections 21 and 22, thence east along the south boundary of sections 22, 23, and 24, T14N, R2W, S. M; thence southeasterly to the southwest protracted corner of section 1, T12N, R1W, S. M; thence southeasterly to the southwest protracted corner of section 34, T12N, R2E, S. M; thence east along the south boundaries of townships 12N, ranges 2E, 3E, 4E and 5E to the east boundary of the Greater Anchorage Area Borough.

V. COMPOSITION AND APPORTIONMENT OF BOROUGH ASSEMBLY: The borough assembly shall consist of seven members for the first assembly following incorporation and until such time as the reapportionment is accomplished under law. The assembly shall be elected as follows: two members elected from Precinct 147; two members from Precinct 148; and one member each from Precincts 149, 150 and 151 but voted on at large in all three precinct. POWERS: The proposed Chugiak - Eagle River Borough shall exercise the areawide powers and duties prescribed by law, (AS 29.33.250) including assessment and collection of taxes, education, planning, platting and zoning, sewers, health, transportation, dog control, library; all areawide and non-area-wide powers presently performed by the Greater Anchorage Area Borough in the defined area to be incorporated; and any additional areawide powers that may be required in accordance with AS 29.33.250, Additional Areawide Powers.

BOROUGHs

SECTION 3. "The entire State shall be divided into boroughs, organized or unorganized. They shall be established in a manner and according to standards provided by law. The standards shall include population, geography, economy, transportation, and other factors. Each borough shall embrace an area and population with common interests to the maximum

degree possible. The legislature shall classify boroughs and prescribe their powers and functions. Methods by which boroughs may be organized, incorporated, merged, consolidated, reclassified, or dissolved shall be prescribed by law."

B. The petitioners submit:

1. The population of the area is interrelated and integrated as to its social, cultural, and economic activities, and is large and stable enough to support organized borough government.
2. The boundaries of the proposed borough conform generally to natural geography and include all areas necessary for full development of local services.
3. The economy of the area includes the human and financial resources capable of providing local services; evaluation of an area's economy includes land use, property valuations, total economic base, total personal income, resource and commercial development, anticipated functions, expenses, and income of the proposed borough.



A Chugiak firm, Klondike-Alaska, Inc., has prepared a street map which is the only one known to be relatively accurate and up-to-date. The map is copyrighted and is used with the permission of the copyright owner.



EXHIBIT B - 1970 CENSUS AND CURRENT ESTIMATES OF POPULATION

The Chugiak - Eagle River area is one of the fastest growing parts of the State of Alaska, increasing from an unofficial estimate of 51 families in 1950 to approximately 720 persons in 1960, to 5,832 in 1970, to an estimated May, 1975 population of 10,010. Before 1990, total population is expected to triple to 30,000 persons.

The 1970 Census reflected an average growth for the entire area at 796% over the 1960 Census. This increase was reflected in all parts of the community except for Eklutna Village which declined from 50 to 25 residents.

Continued growth at this pace will be accommodated by availability of undeveloped land which is in private hands. This fast pace of development requires attention by local government to meet needs such growth generates. These needs can best be met through a government closer to the affected area and to the people it serves. There have been too many problems already experienced caused by lack of familiarity with needs and by regulations designed for a totally different environment. Planning at the local level, with authority to implement local regulations, is needed to handle growth such as that being experienced in Chugiak - Eagle River and which will continue.

Petitioners accept the May, 1975, estimate of 10,010 population by the Greater Anchorage Area Borough Planning Department as being reasonably accurate although it is believed the actual figure is somewhat higher. Information from various sources has been gathered to substantiate population estimates. This data has been obtained from schools, post offices, utilities, and voter registrations and is tabulated on the attached sheet.

Apportionment of the assembly of the proposed borough is based on equal representation principles set forth in guidelines of the U. S. Supreme Court. It is proposed that the assembly be apportioned according to the scheme under which the December 3, 1974 elections for assembly were held. That apportionment scheme had been approved by the Boundary Commission during hearings in November, 1974, and was upheld in court actions.

Assembly composition and apportionment is further discussed on an attached sheet.

ASSEMBLY COMPOSITION AND APPORTIONMENT

An assembly of seven members is proposed for the Chugiak - Eagle River Borough. Apportionment would be among three districts following existing precinct lines. Based on estimated population and voter registration, the apportionment would meet standards and guidelines for constitutional requirements.

Under the apportionment scheme proposed, two members would be elected from a district formed by Precinct 147 boundaries, two members from a district formed by Precinct 148 boundaries as extended to include the portion of Fort Richardson which is contained within the Chugiak - Eagle River Borough, and three members from a district formed by the boundaries of Precincts 149, 150 and 151.

This apportionment scheme is the same as ordered by the Boundary Commission under which the December 3, 1974, special election of officers for the Chugiak - Eagle River Borough was held. That apportionment withstood challenge in Superior Court in Anchorage in November, 1974. (Copy of the decision attached.)

Review of population increases during the period since November, 1974, shows that population variations within the districts have increased proportionately and that the apportionment scheme remains valid. This premise is best based on the relationship between elementary school enrollments and voter registration data. It is noted that school enrollment boundaries generally follow precinct boundaries. Exception is that students from Eagle River South Fork, a sparsely populated area of Precinct 147 located south of the river, attend Eagle River Elementary while other residents within Precinct 147 are included in the Homestead School enrollment area. Birchwood Elementary School enrollment area is coincidental with the Precinct 150 boundary. Chugiak Elementary School serves the entire areas of both Precinct 149 and Precinct 151.

Utility services are not identified within precinct boundaries. Postal patron factors are not a true indicator of population within the respective districts since many Chugiak area residents are served by the Eagle River Post Office. Consideration of these other indicators does not disclose anything which would tend to make the apportionment scheme invalid.

EXHIBIT B - ESTIMATE OF POPULATION

It is proposed that the Assembly of the proposed Chugiak - Eagle River Borough be composed of seven members elected from districts with designated seats. Districts would be apportioned as they were under the plan approved by the Local Boundary Commission for the Chugiak - Eagle River Borough and which was adjudged to be in keeping with guidelines established by the United States Supreme Court in a decision rendered in November, 1974, in the matter of Armstrong vs. State of Alaska.

Under the proposed apportionment, two members would be elected from District 1 which includes all of Precinct 147, Eagle River Valley; two members would be elected from District 2 which includes all of Precinct 148, Eagle River; and three members would be elected from District 3 which includes all of Precincts 149, 150 and 151, to designated seats with Seat E representing Chugiak Precinct 149, Seat F representing Birchwood Precinct 150, and Seat G representing Peters Creek - Eklutna Precinct 151.

Terms of office would be three years, provided, however, that in the first Assembly three members would serve for two years. Holders of the two-year terms in the first Assembly would be determined by lot with drawings held by representatives of each district.

The school board would consist of five members elected at-large within the entire borough.

Review of population increases disclosed no information which would indicate that there has been any change in the proportion of residency among precincts since the apportionment plan was devised in 1974.

MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

On October 2, 1974, Plaintiff filed his COMPLAINT FOR INJUNCTION AND DECLARATORY JUDGMENT and his MOTION FOR PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION OR IN THE ALTERNATIVE FOR A TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER.

The matter came on for hearing on October 17, 1974.

Plaintiff is a registered voter residing near Eagle River, Alaska and within the Eagle River-Chugiak Borough which was established pursuant to Chapter 145, Session Laws of Alaska, 1974, and an election held on August 27, 1974. Pursuant to the aforesaid statute, the Local Boundary Commission held hearings after due notice and established an apportionment for the election of the initial assembly for the new borough. Plaintiff filed this action challenging the apportionment as failing to meet equal representation standards of the United States Constitution. Specifically, plaintiff requested a mandatory injunction directing the Local Boundary Commission to reapportion the borough in compliance with standards enunciated by the Supreme Court of the State of Alaska and to provide for seven individual districts with no "at large" representation; a mandatory injunction directing H. A. "Red" Boucher to order an election

for an initial slate of officers for the borough, as required by the enabling legislation; and in the alternative, that the court adjudge and declare the rights of the plaintiff, particularly that the apportionment plan as proposed by the Local Boundary Commission does meet constitutional requirement of equal representation.

The issue concerning the Lt. Governor's responsibility to set the date for the election of the initial assembly is moot, the Lt. Governor having acted on October 2, 1974.

For the reasons advanced by plaintiff in his reply memorandum dated October 19, 1974, I decline to reach the alternative relief requested by plaintiff. By agreement of the parties, all the issues raised in plaintiff's complaint and motion were litigated at the October 17, 1974 hearing and briefed by the parties. Therefore, the decision on the request for declaratory relief is considered by the court to be a final decision.

The only issue remaining for discussion is the request for injunctive relief compelling the reapportionment of the borough.

There can be no serious dispute that the "equal representation" requirement of the U. S. Constitution applies to local governments. However, it is equally clear that absolute numerical equality is not required. Smaller population, socio-economic considerations and other factors have been held to justify deviations from absolute equality. The cases are discussed in the briefs and no benefit is to be derived from extended discussion here.

The parties did not dispute the use by the Local Boundary Commission of the latest voter registration figures. There seems to be a remarkably high correlation between registered voters and population and the use of current voter registration figures as opposed to older census data is certainly justified here.

Those figures show that each new assemblyman should represent 536 voters. As apportioned, the five districts have the following registered voters and assemblymen:

Dist. No. 1	955	2 Assemblymen 477 voters per assemblyman
Dist. No. 2	1022	2 Assemblymen 511 voters per assemblyman
Dist. No. 3	1773	3 Assemblymen 591 voters per assemblyman

The maximum variation, then, per assemblyman is 114 voters with District No. 1 being over-represented by 11%, per assemblyman, District No. 2 being over-represented by 4.66%, per assemblyman, and District No. 3 being under-represented by about 10.26%. Given the districting scheme established by the Local Boundary Commission, a majority of the assemblymen will have to come from areas representing a majority of the registered voters.


Although the total deviation is 21.26%, we still are concerned with only 114 people. There is no suggestion that the apportionment discriminates against any group because of race, economic status, place of residence or on any other basis. Given the serious time constraints involved, the difficulty of establishing new precinct voting lines and the desire to preserve existing community groups and give those groups a viable voice in the new government, as a group, and the desire of the residents for single member districts, and also the availability of a statutory means to reapportion the borough at a later time

(AS 29.25.020) I find that the apportionment adopted in this case meets equal representation standards of the United States Constitution.

Although alternate plans may have been available, it is not the function of this court to substitute its judgment for that of the agency established to apportion the borough. The court can only review the apportionment to determine that it meets constitutional requirements. Given the difficulty of

establishing new precinct lines and voter lists in time for the election, as well as the rational plan to preserve economic and residential groupings in the borough, and absent any invidious discrimination, I find that the plaintiff is not entitled to injunctive relief.



EXHIBIT C - ASSESSED AND ESTIMATED VALUATION OF ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY
IN THE AREA PROPOSED FOR INCORPORATION

The official valuation of all taxable property within the Chugiak - Eagle River area is \$138,677,000 as established by the Greater Anchorage Area Borough as of January 1, 1975. Property within the Chugiak area was reappraised in 1974. Property within the Eagle River area was last appraised in 1973.

Annual increases in valuation have been difficult to pinpoint because of lag in reassessment cycles. Last reappraisal of property in the Chugiak - Eagle River area had been in 1969. Total valuation in 1973 was approximately \$67,000,000. New construction and reappraisal of Eagle River property raised this amount to \$100,000,000 in 1974. New construction and reappraisal in Chugiak resulted in the increase to \$138,677,000 for 1975. The indicated increase of nearly 100% since 1973 is not accurate because of the lack of reappraisal in the intervening period between 1969 and 1973. Also, until 1974, a portion of property located outside service areas in Chugiak and Eagle River was not identifiable in tax records, at that time being lumped with all lands outside taxing service districts.

In May, 1975, a Greater Anchorage Area Borough building official estimated that residential construction in Chugiak - Eagle River during 1975 would reach \$5,000,000. There are also ten to twenty subdivisions which will be developed during 1975. No estimate of commercial construction is available although two commercial buildings are tentatively planned and another is under construction.

Outlook is bright for future economic growth in Chugiak - Eagle River. Extensive commercial development on a 92 acre tract in the Eagle River business district is expected to begin within two years. Residential construction will continue in order to accommodate increasing population. Many new homes already under construction are in the \$80,000 to \$100,000 bracket.

Development of an industrial area in the vicinity of Birchwood Airstrip to include warehousing facilities on property of the Alaska Railroad is expected to begin in the near future. This area has access to fresh water from Peters Creek which is adjacent.


Another economic potential is currently being realized with development of gravel deposits which are extensive in the Chugiak - Eagle River area and for which there is considerable demand. With proper control, development of this resource can be done in a manner which will enhance the area.

EXHIBIT C (con't)

Proper development of resources and control of the environment can best be gained through local government which is close to the area and responsive to the needs of residents. Distant government could result in retarded or denied development, or on the other hand might allow development which would not be in the best interests of the community.

Another economic potential which must be considered is the large amount of land which is being made available to Eklutna Village under the Native Land Claims Settlement Act. The Village Corporation will gain title to several thousands of acres and is planning for development of a portion of this land in the immediate future. See attached map.

Economically, the Chugiak - Eagle River area is in a sound position to support borough government and has the potential to meet all future needs.



RATE OF TAXATION

EXHIBIT D - THE RATE OR RATES AT WHICH REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY ARE
TAXED IN THE AREA PROPOSED FOR INCORPORATION

All real property and certain items of personal property, including commercial inventories and equipment, are taxed by levy as established by the Greater Anchorage Area Borough.

Areawide levy covers health, mass transportation, planning and zoning, animal control, assessing and collecting and administrative functions. Education levy, also an areawide tax, covers school operation and debt service. These levies apply to all property.

Library service is on a non-areawide basis and tax therefor is levied on all property of the borough outside cities and applies to all property within the Chugiak - Eagle River area.

Landfill service is provided throughout the Chugiak - Eagle River area and is levied for in Service Area 70 which encompasses the area proposed for incorporation.

Fire protection is provided in separate service areas which include portions of Chugiak and portions of Eagle River.

Tax rates for 1975-76 as levied by the Greater Anchorage Area Borough are as follows:

Under budgets prepared for the Chugiak - Eagle River Borough but which had not been acted upon by the Assembly at the time of the Supreme Court ruling dissolving that borough, all services being provided by the Greater Anchorage Area Borough were to be continued by the Chugiak - Eagle River Borough. Library and landfill service would have been included in the areawide levy. If approved by the Assembly as presented, budgets would have required the following levies:

EXHIBIT E - NARRATIVE ON SCHOOL PROGRAM

The following was prepared by Ernest Brannon, president of the Chugiak - Eagle River School Board.

Chapter 14, Section 14.14.060(c) of the Alaska Statutes states..

"The borough school board shall submit the school budget for the following school year to the borough assembly by April 1, for approval of the total amount." The Chugiak - Eagle River School Board prepared and submitted the attached budget to the assembly by that date. It was not the Board's intent to raise or lower the local taxes. The Board's sole mission was to provide a quality educational program.

Basic Education Program

At the time the budget was being prepared, the school foundation program was \$21,750 per instructional unit at a state level support of 94.0875 percent. At that rate, the state would provide \$3,560,763 for the basic educational program. Using this formula, the local area would have to contribute in local taxes the amount of \$1,731,000 or 12.4822 mills, not including debt service.

However, during the time the budget was being prepared, the State House of Representatives passed a bill to increase the school foundation program from \$21,750 to \$23,500. This increase in the foundation program would provide an additional \$286,500. Therefore, if one (1) mill in local taxes equals \$138,677, one can see that this additional revenue from the state foundation program would also reduce local taxes to slightly more than ten (10) mills total for the basic educational program. The Senate subsequently passed the school foundation bill raising the amount to \$23,500.

School Debt Service

When this budget was being prepared, it was not known what the debt service would cost since the assets and liabilities of the borough had not been determined. However, at the time the budget was submitted to the Assembly, Mayor Jordan submitted, to the Board, a schedule of debt service totaling an estimated amount of \$654,214. Therefore, as stated above, if one (1) mill equals \$138,677, the debt service payment would amount to an additional 4.6956 mills to be levied in taxes for schools. Now, if you add 4.6956 mills plus 10.4 mills (approximately), the total tax levy for schools would be slightly over fifteen (15) mills. This does not take into consideration that the Borough Assembly never had the opportunity to review and reduce the budget,

if necessary. However, it was anticipated that the Assembly would reduce the budget by at least two (2) mills. That being true, the total tax levy for schools would be approximately thirteen (13) mills.

The amount of tax paid for education may have been slightly higher under the Chugiak - Eagle River Borough.

However, it is my opinion the general public was willing to pay the difference to be able to run their own program. And, depending on what the budget would be for borough operation, I believe the total mills levied against your property would approximate what you presently pay in taxes to the GAAB for combined school and borough operation.

The school spirit was much higher under the CERB.

It is recommended that the School Board request the Borough Assembly to establish the expenditure limit at \$89,294,704, with local support of \$23,844,469.

EXHIBIT F - THE AMOUNT AND FULL EXPLANATION OF ANY OUTSTANDING BONDED
INDEBTEDNESS FOR WHICH THE AREA IS WHOLLY OR PARTIALLY RESPONSIBLE

Two methods have been used to determine the amount of bonded indebtedness of the Chugiak - Eagle River area. One method, the project cost method, attempts to identify the bond issues utilized for school construction and the remaining balance due on those bonds. The second method, based on a percentage of total assessed valuation, ascribes a pro-rata share of the Greater Anchorage Area Borough areawide debt to the Chugiak - Eagle River area based on relationship of the total assessed value of each of the two areas.

The project cost method is not considered desirable for several reasons. In addition to the predominating argument that any division of either assets and liabilities should be made based on relative interest as shown by assessed value, there is the problem that the project cost method is not accurate. Actual bond issues from which funds were used for construction cannot be identified and there is a further problem in that certain grants were applied to the bond fund balance in accounting by the Anchorage School District and the effect of those grants cannot be determined as applied to projects in Chugiak-Eagle River.

During discussions with finance officers of the Anchorage Borough School District and the Greater Anchorage Area Borough, it was agreed by all parties that the percentage of assessed value method should be utilized in determining the amount of debt for which the Chugiak - Eagle River area is responsible.

Percentage of the total assessed value of property within the Greater Anchorage Area Borough which is situated within the Chugiak - Eagle River area has been computed to be 5.27003629%. Application of this figure to the area-wide bonded indebtedness of the Greater Anchorage Area Borough determines that the amount of bonded indebtedness for which the Chugiak - Eagle River area is responsible would be \$8,016,256.

In addition to this pro-rata share of the areawide bonded indebtedness, there is a bonded indebtedness for the Eagle River Sewer service district of \$1,193,642 as of July 1, 1975.

There is a contingent liability for a debt of \$22,661.16 representing the Chugiak - Eagle River share of an areawide bond issue in the amount of \$430,000 approved by voters of the Greater Anchorage Area Borough in October, 1974. Validity of that bond issue and others approved in February, 1975, have been questioned due to the fact that voters in Chugiak - Eagle River did not

EXHIBIT F (con't)

participate in these elections, being in a separate borough on both of these dates. Only the Emergency Medical Service bond issue for \$430,000 would be attributable as debt in Chugiak - Eagle River, should the bonds be declared valid, inasmuch as other bonds are scheduled for repayment from within specific service areas or districts.

While the full faith and credit of the entire Greater Anchorage Area Borough including Chugiak - Eagle River has been pledged in support of all bond issues of that borough, that fact will have no practical effect upon the bonding capability of the proposed Chugiak - Eagle River Borough. Contacts between bonding consultants and administrators of the former Chugiak - Eagle River Borough have indicated marketability of bonds by the separate borough. In addition, there has been established a Municipal Bond Bank within the State of Alaska which would assist the borough in meeting ¹needs for financing of needed capital improvements.

Copies of detailed studies of the two methods of determining bonded indebtedness liability are attached.

TRANSITIONAL AGREEMENT

EXHIBIT H - TRANSITIONAL INTER-MUNICIPAL AGREEMENTS

Inter-Municipal Agreements are not applicable to this petition inasmuch as there is no official body to agree on behalf of the citizens of Chugiak-Eagle River. It is assumed that transitional provisions would be included in an Order issued by the Local Boundary Commission relative to the incorporation sought in this petition.

Transitional provisions which might be included are discussed in this Exhibit and are offered as suggested provisions in general terms. Copies of this Exhibit are being made available to the Greater Anchorage Area Borough and their comments are being solicited thereon. If these provisions are not concurred in by the Greater Anchorage Area Borough, varying positions could be discussed before the Commission.

Few problems were encountered in the transitional provisions established in Chapter 145, SLA]974, which were being followed for assumption of powers by the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough. Suggestions herein are based largely upon the transitional provisions contained in that legislation.

1. Effective date of incorporation of the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough would be the date of certification of the incorporation election results. Assuming an August election on the question of incorporation, an election should follow in October to elect officials of the new borough. Seating of officials would take place on Monday of the week following the week during which incorporation takes place. Assumption of powers and responsibilities would be not later than July 1, 1976.

2. Effective on the date of incorporation, the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough would succeed to all property, both real and personal, of the Greater Anchorage Area Borough which is situated within the boundaries of the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough. Chugiak-Eagle River Borough would also assume its pro-rata share of all areawide debt and areawide assets of the Greater Anchorage Area Borough on the date of incorporation. The Greater Anchorage Area Borough would agree not to remove, transfer, or in any manner act to reduce any property situated within the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough during the period between setting of an election on the question of incorporation and incorporation date and to refrain from incurring additional areawide debt during such period.

3. Services being provided by the Greater Anchorage Area Borough in the area covered by this petition would continue to be provided following incorporation through the end of the current fiscal year; provided, however, that the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough assembly may, by ordinance duly enacted and upon written notification to the Greater Anchorage Area Borough, assume earlier responsibility for providing any service or exercising any authority at that time being provided by the Greater Anchorage Area Borough. In the event of earlier assumption of power, the Greater Anchorage Area Borough would pay to the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough its pro-rata share of the budgeted amount for the assumed function based on the number of days remaining in the fiscal year.

4. For purposes of the suggested agreement, the pro-rata share of the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough in areawide debts, assets, or budgeted functions would represent its proportionate share of the Greater Anchorage Area Borough property valuation. It has been determined that the percentage factor in this formula is 5.27003629.

5. All ordinances, regulations, rules, and procedures of the Greater Anchorage Area Borough which were applicable to the area covered by this petition on the date of incorporation would remain in full force and effect until adopted, amended, rescinded, or otherwise acted on by the assembly of the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough.

6. The assembly, school board, planning commission, or any duly constituted advisory board of the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough would serve in an advisory capacity to the Greater Anchorage Area Borough during the period of transition.

7. All functions of the Greater Anchorage Area Borough would continue to be provided in the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough area through the end of the current fiscal year, provided, however, that some functions may be phased-in to assure continuity of operation. Platting authority should be delegated to the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough not less than 60 days prior to the end of the current fiscal year.

8. Budgeting for the coming year for services within the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough boundaries would be accomplished by the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough in accordance with statutory requirements. Tax assessing and billing

would be accomplished by the Greater Anchorage Area Borough. Tax statements would be prepared by the Greater Anchorage Area Borough reflecting mill rates established by the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough Assembly and will show the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough address to which tax payments would be made.

9. The Greater Anchorage Area Borough would have the right to exercise collection and foreclosure authority within the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough subsequent to the date of incorporation and after the end of the current fiscal year for any debts or obligations on property situated within the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough incurred prior to the date of incorporation.

10. The Chugiak-Eagle River Borough would on the date of incorporation have all powers of a second class borough and all powers of the Greater Anchorage Area Borough which are applicable to the Chugiak-Eagle River area.

11. The Greater Anchorage Area Borough would provide assistance and cooperation to the administration and officials of the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough in order to assure an orderly transition. Any maps, documents, records, working papers, or other materials applicable to the Chugiak-Eagle River area will be made available to the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough during the transition period and all such material will be turned over to the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough at the end of the current fiscal year or upon earlier assumption of responsibilities.

12. An inventory of all areawide assets of the Greater Anchorage Area Borough, to include all real and personal property as of the date of incorporation, will be prepared by the Greater Anchorage Area Borough for submission to the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough within 90 days following the date of incorporation, together with a statement showing areawide debt of the Greater Anchorage Area Borough as of the date of incorporation.

13. The pro-rata share of the areawide debt, including any liability for operating funds for the current fiscal year, of the Greater Anchorage Borough shall be deducted from the pro-rata share of the areawide assets accruing to the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough. Balance of the pro-rata share of areawide assets shall be credited to the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough for application toward its pro-rata share of annual debt service obligations of the Greater Anchorage Area Borough; such balance to draw interest at an annual rate equalling the average rate of interest of the obligations to which payments are applied, and dating from the first day of the fiscal year following incorporation.

14. Cost of any audit required to substantiate information required in this agreement shall be equally shared by the Greater Anchorage Area Borough and the Chugiak - Eagle River Borough, that portion of the cost for which the Chugiak - Eagle River Borough may be liable to be deducted from its pro-rata share of the areawide assets of the Greater Anchorage Area Borough.

15. In order to prepare for assumption of powers, the Chugiak - Eagle River Borough would employ personnel or consultants necessary to accomplish staffing and budgeting. Operating costs of the Chugiak - Eagle River Borough, except in any instance of powers earlier assumed by ordinance, would be borne by the Chugiak - Eagle River Borough.





Through the petitions and accompanying exhibits which are submitted with this brief, Chugiak-Eagle River Borough Association as petitioners seek to detach the Chugiak-Eagle River area from the Greater Anchorage Area Borough and incorporate a new second class borough in Chugiak-Eagle River. Petitions have been signed by the necessary number of qualified registered voters as specified by statute (19.170-15.270 and AS 29.18.050-29.18-150).

The Chugiak-Eagle River Borough Association was formed initially by elected officials of the former Chugiak-Eagle River Borough immediately following the April 15, 1975, decision of the Supreme Court which ruled unconstitutional Chapter 145, SLA 1974, the Act under which the borough had been created. The association was formalized at a duly advertised public meeting and operates under by-laws adopted by qualified voters of Chugiak-Eagle River at a duly advertised public meeting. A board of directors was elected and includes 14 members, five of whom are officers listed as designee of the petitioners in the accompanying petitions. Co-sponsors of the petition include directors of the Association and other interested individuals.

As shown by maps in Exhibit A, the area proposed for incorporation includes the eastern portion of the existing Greater Anchorage Area Borough and follows boundaries concurrent with those of the Anchorage borough. Dividing line between the two boroughs would be a ridgeline at the crest of mountains separating the Chugiak-Eagle River area from the Anchorage Bowl area and continuing along existing eastern boundary at the City of Anchorage as established by most recent annexations in Fort Richardson.

Incorporation of a separate second class borough is sought by residents of Chugiak-Eagle River in order to gain maximum local self-government which is responsive to the needs and desires of those residents.

Chugiak-Eagle River has historically been separate from the Anchorage area and has needs and desires which are different from those of the Anchorage area. Its needs have not been satisfactorily met by government based in Anchorage.

During 1973 a group of residents began an effort to petition for separation of the Chugiak-Eagle River area from the Greater Anchorage Area Borough and to incorporate a separate second class borough. That effort was abandoned when the Eighth Alaska Legislature enacted what became Chapter 145, SLA 1974. Under provisions of that Act, voters of Chugiak-Eagle River on August 27, 1974, chose to incorporate as a second class borough. Despite heavy opposition, the separate borough was approved by a margin of 56%, 1099 voting for and 855 voting against. Turnout in the election was heavy as compared to the 1972 primary elections with 1954 persons voting in 1974 and 1312 voting in 1972.

The Chugiak-Eagle River Borough was incorporated on September 12, 1974, the date of certification of the election results. On December 3, 1974, voters elected a mayor, seven assembly members and five school board members. Their election was certified December 30, 1974, at which time they took office and began forming the borough government.

A group of residents had, in October, 1974, filed a lawsuit challenging constitutionality of the new borough. Following a hearing in Anchorage Superior Court on December 20, 1974, the borough was upheld in a ruling by Judge Eben Lewis. That ruling was appealed to the state Supreme Court which held hearings January 20, 1975. In a ruling announced April 15, 1975, the Supreme Court ruled that Chapter 145 was unconstitutional and the borough was declared invalid.

During the period September 12, 1974, to April 15, 1975, the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough was organizing in preparation for

assumption of responsibilities on July 1, 1975. Also, during that period, the Greater Anchorage Area Borough went about its business, adjusting its assembly and school board to exclude Chugiak-Eagle River. Approved by voters in Anchorage on February 11, 1975, was creation of a charter commission to prepare a charter leading to possible unification of city and borough governments. At that election, assembly members were elected under a new apportionment plan which had been approved by Anchorage voters in October, 1974. Voters in Chugiak-Eagle River did not participate in those elections.

As a result of the supreme court decision, residents of Chugiak-Eagle River now find themselves without representation on the Anchorage assembly or school board. They are also facing an election to determine whether local government in the Anchorage area will be unified. A Superior Court ruling on June 13, 1975, declared the charter commission was lawfully constituted even though voters in Chugiak-Eagle River had been excluded from participation in its election. The court ordered that residents of Chugiak-Eagle River be treated as Anchorage residents until such time as they are able to again separate from the Greater Anchorage Area Borough.

Residents of Chugiak-Eagle River have historically taken an active interest in local government. They have historically been opposed to unification in the Anchorage area and in 1971 cast 1512 votes in opposition to a charter while giving the charter only 81 votes in support.

Petitioners have found that residents are heavily in favor of a separate borough and that many of those who had been opposed to a separate borough prior to the August 27, 1974, election are now supporting this effort. Although no polls have been taken, petitioners have found that a large majority of residents favor the separate borough and are of the firm opinion that the measure would pass with a margin much larger than in August, 1974.

Support for the separate borough has grown after it was shown that the area has the human and financial resources capable of supporting local government and that the separate borough can provide

a full range of services at a satisfactory level and in a responsive manner at reasonable tax cost. Most residents had been pleased with the budgets and organizational structures prepared for the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough and with the direction being given in planning and zoning and education matters.

Chugiak-Eagle River residents have not been given adequate attention by the Greater Anchorage Area Borough. In view of continuing efforts to unify city and borough governments in Anchorage, creating an even larger and less responsive government, the separate borough becomes even more desirable. There have been many situations in which the Chugiak-Eagle River area has not been satisfactorily served under the Greater Anchorage Area Borough. Some examples of these situations are the following:

The Eagle River sewer system is overcrowded and trunk lines have been extended beyond treatment capacity. State regulations require hook-up at all properties within 200 feet of sewer trunks, yet the treatment plant cannot accomodate additional connections. Expansion has not been planned for and no action has been taken to relieve the situation which is hampering development of the area. As a result, a moratorium against new connections will be imposed and no extensions of laterals will be possible even though several valid petitions for extensions have been received.

No funds have ever been expended for secondary roads and trails in the Chugiak-Eagle River area even though the state program was designed to upgrade or construct roads and trails in areas which do not have road powers. In 1975, funds amounting to \$66,699. were made available to the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough under this program. Previously, such funds were only utilized in areas of the Greater Anchorage Area Borough which had road powers.

Residents of portions of Eagle River petitioned for road maintenance service district powers in 1972, desiring to obtain snowplowing and minor maintenance. It had been estimated locally that this service could be provided at a cost of approximately one-half mill. When the proposal was submitted by the Anchorage borough,

however, it would have entailed upgrading of all roads complete with traffic control, lighting and storm drainage with an attendant tax rate of three mills for the first six month period. The measure did not gain voter approval.

A swimming pool has been built at Chugiak High School but is currently available only for use by students during school hours. The Greater Anchorage Area Borough appears unable to reach a solution to make the facility available for public use.

Although a borough service center was established in Eagle River in 1972, services available have not been increased. Residents of Chugiak-Eagle River must travel to Anchorage to obtain dog licenses, pay taxes, apply for permits and to gain information.

These are only some examples of neglect or non-responsiveness on the part of the Anchorage borough. Other examples could be listed.

The Chugiak-Eagle River area is currently not represented on the Anchorage assembly and if the present apportionment into four districts is maintained, it is highly unlikely that Chugiak-Eagle River will again have direct representation. From incorporation of the borough in 1964 until it was reapportioned in 1974, the borough assembly had been apportioned into six single-member districts outside the City of Anchorage. Under the plan adopted in October, 1974, four districts were created from which the eleven assembly members are elected. Under at-large voting for school board members, Chugiak-Eagle River has not had direct representation for over six years.

Chugiak-Eagle River had an opportunity to prove what could be done with its own local government during the borough's short existence. Budgets had been prepared to provide all services previously provided by the Greater Anchorage Area Borough. Upon return of the Chugiak-Eagle River area to GAAB, supplemental budgets for governmental services were prepared. Comparison of the budgets proposed by the two borough administrations showed that cost of services would be \$300,000. more under the Anchorage borough than under the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough.

Local government under the proposed separate borough would be responsible to its residents and can be provided at reasonable rates of taxation. Creation of the separate borough would relieve many problems both in Chugiak-Eagle River and in the Anchorage area. It would resolve the many questions arising from the decision which voided the former borough.

The Chugiak-Eagle River area meets the standards for incorporation as a borough as set forth in AS 29.18.030. As defined therein, these standards are:

- (1) The population of the area is interrelated and integrated as to its social, cultural and economic activities, and is large and stable enough to support organized borough government;
- (2) The boundaries of the proposed borough conform generally to natural geography and include all areas necessary for full development of local services;
- (3) The economy of the area includes the human and financial resources capable of providing local services; evaluation of an area's economy includes land use, property valuations, total economic base, total personal income, resource and commercial development, anticipated functions, expenses and income of the proposed borough;
- (4) Land, water and air transportation facilities allow the communication and exchange necessary for the development of integrated local government.

The Alaska Legislature, charged by the Constitution with establishing the manner and standards by which boroughs are established, has twice specified that the Chugiak-Eagle River area does meet the standards for incorporation as a borough. The Eighth Legislature stated this finding in Chapter 145, SLA 1974. The Ninth Legislature more specifically stated this finding in HCR 67, 1975.

Population of the Chugiak-Eagle River area is discussed in Exhibit - B - accompanying this petition. Total number of persons residing within the area is estimated at 10,010 as of May 1, 1975. This estimate is made by the planning department of the Greater

Anchorage Area Borough and is accepted by the petitioners as being reasonably accurate. In the Official 1970 Census, total population was listed as 5,832, an increase for the total Chugiak-Eagle River area of 790% over the 1960 Census. This rapid growth is reflected in school enrollments, voter registration, electric utility service connections, telephone connections and postal service. Growth will continue at a rapid pace because of the availability of land for further residential development and an increasing development of industrial and commercial facilities which provide employment opportunities. Projections for growth are in keeping with attendant projections for Southcentral Alaska as a whole and in particular for the environs of the Greater Anchorage Area Borough and the Matanuska Susitna Borough. Formation of the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough would enhance continued growth and economic development through local planning and direction, meeting human needs and encouragement of sound development.

Average age of residents of the Chugiak-Eagle River area is in the age group of 25-40 years, reflecting a more mature population than in the Greater Anchorage Area Borough, as a whole. A large number of three-generation families are included within the population, reflecting a considerable degree of stability. Of the 51 families who obtained the first electric power extension to the Chugiak area from Matanuska Electric Association a quarter century ago, more than half that number and their progeny continue to reside within the area.

Employment of the largest percentage of residents of Chugiak-Eagle River is connected with civilian capacities on adjacent military reservations.

Employment of residents of the Chugiak-Eagle River area is varied and covers all fields from professional persons to unskilled laborers. There is a preponderance of skilled craftsmen included within the population. Major source of employment is in civilian capacities on adjacent military reservations. Next highest percentage of the work force is involved in construction-related capacities.

Unemployment statistics are slightly under those for the Greater Anchorage Area Borough. There are a small number of retired persons residing within the Chugiak-Eagle River area.

Residents of the Chugiak-Eagle River area have generally and historically exhibited an independent and self-sufficient nature. They are active socially and politically and maintain a high degree of civic pride. Settlement of the area began during the 1940's and in 1947 a community club was formed, selecting the name "Chugiak." In 1950 they gained extension of electric power lines from Matanuska Electric Association in Palmer. In the early 1950's they formed the Chugiak Benefit Association and began production of annual Spring Carnivals. Also during the Fifties, the first subdivisions were developed and a shopping area was established. Residents banded together to gain construction of schools; first at Chugiak in 1948, then at Eagle River in 1955, and Chugiak High School in 1963. They have been extremely active with a large number of organizations for youth sports programs, arts and crafts, home-makers, social clubs, civic clubs, improvement associations, government study groups and others.

Healthfully divided on local issues within their community, residents of Chugiak-Eagle River display a oneness of mind when it comes to issues involving the entire community. As an example, their stand against unification of the Greater Anchorage Area Borough has been almost unanimous as evidenced by the 1971 charter vote in which 81 votes were cast in favor and 1512 in opposition.

Boundaries of the proposed Chugiak-Eagle River Borough conform to natural geography. Its northern boundary generally follows a Township line concurrent with the boundary of the Matanuska-Susitna Borough through mountainous terrain. Western boundary follows the center of Knik Arm to a point intersecting with the Anchorage city limits then follows that boundary toward the east to connect with the ridgeline of the Chugach Mountains which is the southern boundary, then follows a meridian line through glacial fields which is concurrent with the existing boundary of the Greater Anchorage

Area Borough. Division line between the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough and the Greater Anchorage Area Borough follows a mountain ridge line for most of the distance, then conforms to existing city limits of the City of Anchorage. No boundary changes would be involved for the City of Anchorage or the Matanuska-Susitna Borough.

The area included within the boundaries of the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough includes all areas necessary for development of local services. Approximately 900 square miles is included within the proposed borough and is comprised of varying topography; ample for residential development with suitable lands also available for industrial and commercial development. Watersheds are available and can be protected to assure future supplies of water. Drainage to Knik Arm provides run-off escapement. Considerable recreational potential is available within the proposed boundaries. Habitable areas of the proposed borough are accessible through existing road networks or can be developed through new roads.

The economy of the area includes the human and financial resources capable of providing local services. As certified by the Greater Anchorage Area Borough in April, 1975, assessed value of real and personal property situated within the proposed Chugiak-Eagle River Borough on January 1, 1975, was \$138,677,000. Property within the Chugiak area was reassessed during 1974; property within the Eagle River area was reappraised during 1973. With a healthy employment rate, a large and stable population and a growing rate of development, the proposed borough has a sound basis on which to establish local government.

Current land use is primarily residential with a full range of densities provided, from multiple-family development in and near the commercial centers and ringed by single-family areas with large lot development in outlying areas. Many large tracts are held in private ownership.

An urban center is located in the Eagle River area. Neighborhood business areas have developed at various centers near transportation hubs in other parts of the proposed borough. An industrial

area is proposed in the vicinity of Birchwood Airstrip where there is an adjacent railroad storage area with existing spurs and is abutted by Peters Creek with a large flow of fresh water. This area is also accessible to existing highways. The proposed borough area contains extensive deposits of gravel which are extremely valuable and which may be developed under controlled conditions which would enhance the surrounding areas and provide more useable land for further residential and commercial development.

The proposed borough would perform all functions necessary to meet human needs, maintain services currently being provided, and plan for additional services as requested by residents. Budgets had been prepared by the mayor and school board and were under consideration by the assembly when the Supreme Court decision was rendered. Summaries of those budgets are included among the exhibits accompanying the petitions.

The school budget reflected operation of four elementary schools and one junior-senior high school complex on a basis of maintaining a sound educational program. It provided for salary schedules commensurate with those of nearby districts in order to attract and retain qualified personnel. Reading, music, special education and other programs were provided in both elementary and secondary schools. Also provided for was a contractual arrangement to continue a comprehensive vocational education program.

The general borough budget placed emphasis on sound management to give the borough a favorable financial posture in collecting and accounting for funds and to present a favorable bonding capability. Services would have been provided at an adequate level to assure that needs were timely and effectively met.

A tax rate had not been determined by the assembly since it had not had the opportunity to hold hearings and act on either the proposed budgets or methods of financing. It is apparent from the proposed budgets that the Chugiak-Eagle River area can continue to provide a full range of services, prepare for new services and meet

its capital improvement needs at a moderate tax rate which is well under allowable limitations imposed by state statutes. Continued growth of the area within the proposed borough boundaries is assured and the increasing tax base will offset increased demand for services.

It has been amply demonstrated that the Chugiak-Eagle River area has the land, water and air transportation facilities to allow the communication and exchange necessary for the development of integrated local government. There are currently more than 70 miles of state primary and secondary roads connecting inhabited areas of the proposed borough. Local service roads connect residential areas to feeder and arterial roads. The area is also traversed by the rail route of the Alaska Railroad. Its western boundary is Knik Arm, a navigable waterway. Air transportation is available through both float and wheel equipped aircraft based at Birchwood Airstrip, two private strips in the Eagle River area, and at Fire and Mirror Lakes. In addition to these transportation facilities, the Chugiak Eagle River area is served by various other communication media including post offices, telephones and newspapers.

Upon re-incorporation of the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough, governmental functions would continue during a transitional period, provided by the Greater Anchorage Area Borough. It is anticipated that few transitional problems will arise with most having been anticipated and under resolution during the formation of the invalidated borough. A tentative agreement is being prepared and will be submitted and discussed in a separate document based on suggestions by Mr. Jack Chenoweth of the Department of Community and Regional Affairs. An inter-municipal agreement covering transition is not possible since there is no municipality to represent the residents of Chugiak-Eagle River. Possible provisions which might be included in a Boundary Commission Order are being prepared and will be submitted to the Greater Anchorage Area Borough for comment.

Petitioners for the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough recognize that other areas of the state are interested in the success with which

this petition is met. It is also recognized that two previous attempts to separate areas from existing boroughs have not been successful. Precedent is a factor which is expected to weigh in any decision concerning this petition.

The Boundary Commission holds within its jurisdiction the power to determine the merits of each petition on its individual circumstances. For this reason, creation of a separate borough in Chugiak-Eagle River will not necessarily be followed by a number of other separations. If there is interest in detachment and separate incorporation in other boroughs, it is an indication that there is considerable dissatisfaction with the procedures under which boroughs are operating in Alaska. It is within the province of the Boundary Commission to determine whether areas should incorporate or whether some other remedy should be provided.

In the case of Chugiak-Eagle River there are a unique set of circumstances which dictate that detachment from the Greater Anchorage Area Borough and incorporation of a separate borough is the most desirable mechanism through which maximum local government can be gained. Detachment will have no serious effect on the remaining area of the existing borough. Its ability to govern will continue unhampered. Residents of surrounding areas will not be denied any protection as a result of the proposed incorporation of the Chugiak-Eagle River Borough.

Residents of Chugiak-Eagle River have expressed at the polls their approval of the proposed borough and have done so again in these petitions. They demand their right to gain a more responsive government and to have control over their own affairs.

The Alaska Legislature is empowered by the State Constitution with establishing the standards for incorporation, for setting forth procedures under which incorporation is gained and for altering boundaries. Two Legislatures, the Eighth and Ninth, have stated that the Chugiak-Eagle River area meets the standards for incorporation. In Chapter 145, SLA 1974, the legislative finding so stated. The Ninth Legislature, in HCR 67, also stated that the Chugiak-

Eagle River area meets the standards for incorporation as a borough.

Expeditious review of the petition is essential in view of changes being made in the Anchorage area. A vote is expected to be held early in August concerning a unification charter. Reapportionment of the Anchorage assembly has been made necessary by the return of Chugiak-Eagle River to the Greater Anchorage Area Borough. Assembly elections are scheduled in October and would be held under the new apportionment scheme.

Petitioners ask the Department of Community and Regional Affairs to determine that these petitions are complete and sufficient and to make a favorable recommendation to the Boundary Commission. The Boundary Commission is asked to decide in favor of these requests and to recommend that an election be held at the earliest possible time on the following question:

"SHALL CHUGIAK-EAGLE RIVER DETACH FROM THE GREATER ANCHORAGE AREA BOROUGH AND INCORPORATE AS A SEPARATE SECOND CLASS BOROUGH?

A comprehensive budget for general borough and school operations was prepared by the administration and school board of the Chugiak - Eagle River Borough. These budgets had not been acted on at the time of the Supreme Court decision which voided incorporation of that borough.

PRIOR YEAR LIABILITY

Because of the method of funding of the Greater Anchorage Area Borough, the Chugiak - Eagle River Borough would have a liability for funding services between January 1, 1975 and June 30, 1975. Prior Year Liability, determined by applying 5.27% to total interim financing for 1976FY is \$673,633.

DEBT SERVICE

Total debt service of Chugiak - Eagle River Borough is \$8,689,541. This includes principal, interest.

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(NOTE: Prior Year Liability is not included in the above figures because the Chugiak - Eagle River Borough is entitled to a share of the assets of the Greater Anchorage Area Borough on the same percentage formula as applied to debt service. Actual determination of the extent of those assets has not been made, however it is anticipated that the share attributable to the Chugiak - Eagle River Borough would exceed the amount of the prior year liability.

ASSESSED VALUATION

Assessed valuation of the Chugiak - Eagle River Borough was \$138,677,000 with one mill representing \$138,677. Based on this figure, funding of the budgets as proposed by the School Board and Borough Administration would require a mill levy of 19.45. Indications from members of the Assembly and community input made it apparent that Assembly action would have reduced the amounts required to be funded from local sources by approximately \$400,000 and would have increased revenue from local sources by initiating charges in certain areas such as health services, animal control, and planning and zoning to gain approximately \$80,000. This action would be reflected by a mill rate of approximately 16.7.

CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS

Capital Improvements were not included in the proposed budgets for 1975-76 due to lack of time for planning. It was proposed to begin construction in 1975 on a new fire station in Eagle River and to initiate design for expansion of the sewer lagoon and lateral system. Funds had been included for this work in the administrative budget. Present school facilities are adequate for the coming year, however plans were to begin studies for new construction in 1977.

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BY-LAWS of the Chugiak - Eagle River Borough Association were adopted May 12, 1975, at a general membership meeting called for that purpose, with the following amendment:

ARTICLE V - OFFICERS

(g) A Board of Directors shall be elected from the general membership to include the aforementioned officers. The Board of Directors shall consist of 14 members from all sections of the community, and the decisions of the Board shall be binding on the officers and general membership.

BY-LAWS
OF
CHUGIAK - EAGLE RIVER BOROUGH ASSOCIATION*

ARTICLE I

NAME

This organization shall be known as the Chugiak - Eagle River Borough Association. Its principal office shall be located within the limits of the Chugiak - Eagle River area. Its mailing address shall be P. O. Box 700, Eagle River, Alaska 99577.

ARTICLE II

ORGANIZATION

This organization shall be a volunteer non-profit unincorporated organization.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSE

The purpose of this organization shall be:

- (1) To publicize the pro's and con's of the establishment of a local government entity for the Chugiak - Eagle River area, which shall include Fire Lake, Birchwood, Peters Creek, Eklutna, Eagle River Valley, South Fork and any other areas which may be contiguous to the aforementioned population areas.
- (2) To circulate a petition to be signed by a sufficient number of residents of the aforementioned areas for the establishment of a second-class borough.
- (3) To present said petition and all other required facts and documents to the existing local government authorities (GAAB, State of Alaska, Dept. of Community and Regional Affairs).
- (4) To appear as witnesses in any state and local hearings related to said petition for the formation of a second-class borough.
- (5) To encourage placement of the question of formation of a second-class borough on a ballot to be voted on by the registered voters of the Chugiak - Eagle River area at a special election held by the State of Alaska.

ARTICLE IV

MEMBERSHIP

Any registered voter residing in the Chugiak - Eagle River area is eligible for membership in this association. Members shall not be assessed dues.

ARTICLE V

OFFICERS

The officers shall be a Chairman, 1st Vice-Chairman, 2nd Vice-Chairman, Secretary, and Assistant Secretary and Treasurer, whose duties shall be those usually performed by such officers and those specified in these By-Laws. The officers shall be elected at the first general meeting from a slate of individuals nominated from the floor. The terms of office shall be perpetual until this association has concluded the purposes stated in Article III of these By-Laws.

- (a) The Chairman shall be the chief officer of the organization and shall preside at all meetings.
- (b) The 1st Vice-Chairman shall perform all duties of the chairman in his absence.
- (c) The 2nd Vice-Chairman shall perform all duties of the chairman in the absence of the chairman and 1st vice-chairman.
- (d) The secretary shall attend all meetings and keep minutes, be custodian of all organization records, issue notices of all meetings and call the meetings to order in the absence of the chairman and vice-chairmen until a chairman pro tem is elected.
- (e) The Assistant Secretary and Treasurer shall hold the funds deposited with him or her and pay them out on the orders of the officers of the association and shall make a full financial report at each meeting.
- (f) Officers shall serve without salary.

ARTICLE VI

MEETINGS

General meetings of this association shall be held on call of the chairman or any three officers. Meetings shall be open to the public. The place, date and time of a meeting shall be noticed in the area news media and/or posted in conspicuous public places at least one week in advance of said meeting. A meeting of fifteen members shall constitute a quorum.

Meetings may be called by written petition signed by any fifteen members. Petitions shall be submitted to the secretary and shall state the business to be introduced at the meeting. The secretary shall notify the officers, who shall set a date, time and place for the requested meeting. Said meeting shall be noticed in the area news media and/or posted in conspicuous public places at least one week in advance.

ARTICLE VII

COMMITTEES

The officers may appoint an advisory committee representative of each local voting precinct to carry out the purposes of the association. It shall be the function of the committee to investigate and make recommendations and report to the officers of this association.

ARTICLE VIII

PARLIAMENTARY AUTHORITY

The rules contained in Robert's Rules of Order - Newly Revised shall govern all meetings of the officers and members of this association.

ARTICLE IX

GENERAL PROVISIONS

(1) FUNDS. All funds of this association shall be under the direction and control of the officers of this association. No obligation or expense shall be incurred or paid out of the association accounts for other than association purposes. All disbursements shall be made by duly signed checks having a minimum of two signatures of association officers. A petty cash fund of \$25.00 may be maintained.

(2) RECORDS. All records of the association shall be open to inspection by the members.

(3) AMENDMENTS. These By-Laws may be amended by a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of those present at any meeting providing that notice of the proposed change shall have been published at least once in the area news media and/or posted in conspicuous public places for at least seven days prior to the meeting at which the proposed amendment is to be considered.
